

2011 Summer Employment Opportunities

Camp of Dreams is seeking motivated, creative, experienced applicants for summer camp counselor positions. Applicants must be available to work at camp from June 19 to July 16, which includes one week of staff training and three weeks of camp. Duties will include but are not limited to instructing 2 enrichment classes per day as well as being responsible for the daily living activities of campers aged 9-17 (approximately 8-10 campers per cabin).

Camp of Dreams is a Chicago-based program devoted to bringing uplifting, engaging, free educational programs to young people who might otherwise go without. Our project as a whole brings a wide range of activities to our participants in the areas of: Mind (Academics), Body (Health & Wellness), and Spirit (Character Development/ Cultural Awareness). Through our school year program and summer camp, our Dreamers are better able to make informed, healthy life choices and be well-rounded, active community members.

Required Qualifications:

- Desire and ability to work with children in an outdoor environment
- Experience working/volunteering with diverse populations, particularly youths from urban areas
- Ability to relate to one's peer group
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Good character, integrity, and adaptability, enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control
- Ability to pass a criminal background check
- High school graduate or equivalent and at least 18 years of age

General Duties:

- Guide cabin or unit groups and individual campers in participating successfully in all aspects of camp activities
- Develop opportunities for interaction between campers and staff
- Develop cabin or group activity plans with participants as appropriate and provide opportunities that allow each individual to experience success during camp
- Prepare for and actively participate in staff training, meetings, and supervisory conferences
- Set a good example for campers and others including cleanliness, punctuality, teamwork, sportsmanship, and respect for personal property, camp equipment, and facilities

Applicants should also possess and be able to foster in Dreamers the following traits or 7 C's:

Good <u>Communication</u> skills; <u>Cultural</u> awareness; <u>Civic</u>-engagement; Good self <u>Care</u>; sense of <u>Community</u>; <u>College/Career</u> Goals; and Good <u>Character (i.e., independence, hope, accountability, etc...)</u>

Positions Available:

Junior Counselor:

- *Education*: At least a High School Diploma/G.E.D.
- *Experience*: At least 1 year of camp experience as participant and/or counselor
- *Compensation*: Pay rates start at \$1,000/camp session depending on education level and experience
- Specific Duties:
 - Directly supervised by Assistant Camp Director; reports to Camp Director
 - Supervise all assigned aspects of the campers' day, including morning circle, cabin clean-up, meal times, rest hour, evening activities, bedtime preparations, and after-hours duty as assigned.
 - Help each participant meet the goals established by the camp for camper development
 - o Develop/schedule evening group activities and assist in teaching or leading an activity, as assigned.
 - Submit all required reports on time

Senior Counselor:

- *Education*: Must have completed junior year of college/associate's degree or at least 21 years of age
- Experience: At least 2 years of camp experience as participant and/or counselor
- *Compensation*: Pay rates start at \$1,400, depending on education level and experience
- Specific Duties:
 - o Directly supervised by Assistant Camp Director; reports to Camp Director
 - Supervise all assigned aspects of the campers' day, including morning circle, cabin clean-up, meal times, rest hour, evening activities, bedtime preparations, and after-hours duty as assigned.
 - Be responsible for the welfare of each individual in the cabin and assist any campers or junior staffers who may need help adjusting to camp environment
 - Mentor assigned junior counselors or counselors-in-training
 - o Conduct or delegate responsibility for inspection of cabins and areas
 - Develop/schedule evening group activities and assist in teaching or leading an activity, as assigned.
 - Submit all required reports on time

Assistant Camp Director (males):

- *Education*: At least a bachelor's degree
- Experience: At least 2 or more years of camp experience, with personnel management experience preferred
- *Compensation*: Pay rates start at \$1,600
- Specific Duties:
 - Directly supervised by Camp Director
 - Be responsible for the welfare of all male campers and counselors and assist any campers or junior staffers who may need help adjusting to camp environment
 - Assist Camp Director in supervision, mentoring, and evaluation of jr./sr. counseling staff including at least 2 formal evaluations of staff and conducting other evaluations as necessary
 - o Train and supervise counselors-in-training (CITs); i.e., lead CIT workshops, chaperone CIT activities, etc...
 - Visit cabins and classes regularly to interact with campers and schedule daily check-ins with staffers to help evaluate the camp programming
 - In the event a male counselor is ill or his employment is terminated, temporarily lead the cabin group's activities
 - o Submit all required reports on time
